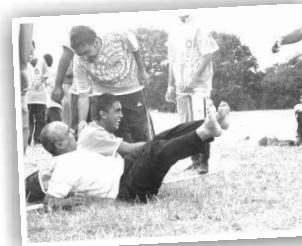
Your child will be able to take part in various practical workshops which will enable them to increase their understanding about the Swaminarayan Sampraday.
